## **CSA Begins 14th Year**

In the Fall of 1983, six men with various scientific backgrounds met to organize an effort to research and publicly proclaim the validity and importance of Biblical Creation, while simultaneously opposing its eternal enemy - evolution. [History records that Evolution as a concept has been around as long as man, though the word "evolution" has been used to describe it for only a short while.] We sent out a flyer to a few people announcing our first meeting in December 1983. We invited Walter Lang, founder of the Bible Science Association, to be our guest speaker. Forty-five people attended. The meeting attracted several others who would become active in CSA.

Some active workers have left the area, others were less interested than they originally thought, but generally their shoes have been filled by others who have joined the ranks:

Larry Rink, who joined us at our first public meeting, was already active and productive in this work, and remains so today. In addition to being an active public speaker and researcher, Larry maintains and operates the **CSA Lending Library** and conducts all the Astronomy Safaris.

Ken Carlson, a fuels consultant specializing in electric power generation with a major international consulting firm, began showing up at nearly every CSA function. He became so fascinated with the 1980 eruption of Mt. St. Helens and its implications for the origin of coal, that he began researching the subject wherever he went. Today, Ken's presentation, "The Eruption of Mount St. Helens - Life-sized Laboratory in Rapid Formation of Sediment Layers, Canyons, and Coal," contains convincing proofs that these geologic formations not only could have formed quickly, but must have!

Bob Farwell, was an atheist/evolutionist science teacher, became a Christian/Creationist, and has become a very popular **CSA** speaker, appealing to all ages. As a teacher, he has much experience communicating with young people. Initially he relied heavily on the research and concepts of others, but has now become a much more active researcher and thinker on his own. Bob now leads, or helps lead, virtually all **CSA Safaris** (except astronomy).

Glenn Kailer was a frequent **CSA** visitor for several years before he decided, in February of 1990, that the Lord was leading him to join CSA on a full time basis. Starting with only conviction and virtually no money Glenn has become one of the most active and effective Creation Speakers in the country. One, among his many accomplishments, is that Glenn is host of a **one hour daily** radio talk show entitled "Science and Reason" on the Amerinet Broadcasting Network, Satellite: Galaxy 6, Transponder 23, Audio 8.1 Wide Band. Glenn is on national radio more hours per week, with a show focusing on

## Is There Life on Mars?

If you have watched TV, read a magazine or paper, or listened to the radio in the last two months or so, you surely know "Science has discovered life on Mars." At CSA, we have received many phone calls and letters asking about this "discovery." Most sane folks regard true science to be something man thinks he has discovered about the physical universe and has rigorously demonstrated the truth of his claim by sound reasoning about the meaning of incontestable evidence. Let us consider the "Life on Mars" claims and evidence:

- 1 Exorbitant claims were made. While the headlines varied and often contained some hedges, the subheads and text of the articles I saw largely claimed pretty solid evidence for Life on Mars. Consider USA Today Wed, Aug. 7, 1996, page 3A, the first line in a large box, "The Martian Chronicle," is "An ancient meteorite provides unmistakable evidence that life once existed on Mars, scientists say." Later they state "Chemical analysis... identifies it as originating from Mars," and "Scientists from NASA and several universities say they found organic molecules..."
- 2 Claims like the ones above by the press were more exorbitant than those made by the researchers.
- 3 Far from all scientists agreed with the claims. As near as I can tell, *Science* magazine published one recent article by the team producing the claims ("Search for Past Life on Mars; Possible Relic Biogenetic Activity in Martian Meteorite ALH84001" (272:924-930)), but also published "Mars Media Mayhem," (274:161). Interesting remarks appear in *Nature*, "Opening Martian Can of Worms? (382:575-576).
- 4 The claim is often stated and nearly always implied that this "discovery" somehow supports evolution and will "only trouble creationists and Christian fundamentalists who adhere to a literal interpretation of the Bible (Monmaney L.A. Times, Saturday, Aug. 31, 1996). Even NASA Administrator Daniel Goldin gave support to this claim, asserting that this "gets to the foundations of beliefs of the human species." \* The fact that the Earth was created before stars, that the Earth is the focus of history and the sin of one man resulted in a curse on the entire creation should cause sensible Christians to view with skepticism claims of life in space. But, the Bible does not state that life exists only on Earth. As usual, non-Christian commentaries on Christianity are wrong. Incidentally, the "discovery" does not support evolution. Available evidence does not support the notion of evolution of life on earth, it certainly does not support it on Mars. If life was on Mars, it was undoubtedly created, and, as a number of scientists have suggested, it is just as likely to have traveled

Countless others have contributed much. Mark Chriestenson has faithfully audio and video taped our meetings for many years. Bruce MacArthur has faithfully set up the meetings for several years and recently located, ordered, installed, tested and documented the software needed to hold our mailing expenses down under the new Postal Regulations for bulk mail. If we examine all the data, we find that the "evidence" supporting these claims is a bit shallow (the text following the \* contains our comments):

- A Meteorite, called ALH84001, weighing 4-1/2 pounds, was discovered in Antarctica in 1984. The original paper, published in *Science*, attracted little attention.
- The meteorite is unusual composition, only about 11 meteorites have been discovered with similar composition.

  One of the other similar rocks (EET79001), not from the same location, contains some "crystallized bubbles" claimed to be similar to Mars atmosphere. \* The argument goes like this: One rock contains "crystallized bubbles" that provide some support for the notion that it might have come from Mars. The other 11 rocks have other similarities to each other, therefore they might also have, maybe, come from Mars.
- The composition of **none** of the meteorites is similar in any way to rocks actually brought back from Mars. \* To most scientists, this means they probably didn't come from Mars. Strangely, to others, it means they must have come from deep under the Martian surface.
- One of the rocks (ALH84001) (the one generating the news) has high concentrations of polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH's). One way these can be produced is chemical alteration of organic matter (living, or once living matter). \* There are many inorganic ways too, including processes required in the most popular theories of planet formation. PAH's are found in interstellar space.
- The one biggie rock (ALH4001) contains "carbonate globules" with magnetite crystals and iron-sulfide minerals which are produced by some bacteria on earth. \* But all these chemicals commonly form by inorganic (nonliving) processes. If you have spent any time around evolvoland, you know that "globules" are often strong evidence of life popping out of rocks. What is a globule? Well it's anything round... or almost round.
- The *globules* were shaped somewhat like eggs... or tubes, therefore they may be fossilized bacteria. \* Here come those globules again. If they are fossilized bacteria, they are 100 times smaller than any life ever discovered on earth. Therefore, there is no scientific reason to believe that they are bacteria.
- The press conference announcing this "discovery" was called by NASA. \* NASA's budget has been dwindling considerably lately (who says Clinton hasn't done anything good?). The religious/philosophical motive behind all this "Life on Mars" hoopla is obvious, but the financial motive is hardly any less obvious.

Th..th..th.. that's all folks. You can believe "An ancient meteorite provides unmistakable evidence life once existed on Mars" if you choose. As for little old fundamentalist me, I'll stick with my old-fashioned Bible.
