More Great *Proofs* of Evolution

"The Laws of Cause and Effect, and the 1st and 2nd Laws of Thermodynamics have been invalidated by modern science" Part 2

This article began in the Jan/Feb, 2000 CSA News, which you must read if you expect to understand this segment. The astute among you may have noticed we haven't yet really honed in "directly" on the subject. Rather than apologizing, I'll simply note that we will in the next installment.

The Cosmos According to "Science"

We began by asking "Are the Laws of Classical Physics True?" We then followed with a brief summary of only one area of "Classical Physics," "What really moves in the heavens?" We discussed that everyone knows that it is a fact of science that the earth goes around the sun. For man's current "scientific" understanding of the Cosmos to be true, the earth rotates daily, and circles the sun annually; the sun is racing through space at various rates, depending on which theory is most popular today, dragging the solar system with it. There are "fixed stars," or, more popularly today, "fixed galaxies." It all began with a huge explosion (or, more popular today, a "big expansion"). All of the elements were produced with atomic fusion, a few during the "big expansion," the rest in nuclear fusion during star explosions. All systems of the Cosmos are the result of gravity recalling the debris of these "expansions and explosions" and placing it in massively complex rotational systems. The entire system is described as cyclic, lasting billions of years, with its ultimate destiny somewhere between continued expansion into nothingness to collapse back into a "black hole."

The Cosmos According to the Bible

Interestingly, a straightforward interpretation of the Bible would lead anyone to believe that the Earth was created first, it was created virtually instantaneously (Genesis 1,2) only a few thousand years ago (Genesis 4,5 and 10-12 give the names of one line of descendants from the first week down to known historical times. The literal meaning of these passages are repeatedly confirmed in the New Testament, Luke 3:23-38, Jude 1:14, Galations 3:17). The Bible strongly states that the earth can be shaken, but does not move at all (Ps 93:1). But the sun does move (e.g., Joshua 10:12-14) and does so in a circuit (Psalm 19:1-6). Some will argue "that is only your interpretation." My response is simply, "It is not an interpretation at all, it is what the words say. Try making them say that God took billions of years to build the earth, it happened billions of years ago, and it travels around the sun." Now, what does the evidence say? In the last segment, we suggested that all experiments to demonstrate that the earth moves at all have failed. All seem to indicate the earth does not move at all. There is much evidence that the earth is young and cannot possibly be millions, much less billions of years old but we will not treat that herein. While it is much more difficult to prove how quickly the earth was formed, there is, in fact hard evidence that it must have formed quickly because it could **not** have formed slowly, again, beyond the scope of this essay, but readily available elsewhere.

What About Earth's Place in the Cosmos?

The Bible does not say that the earth is at the center of the universe. But, anyone looking up can see that the sun, planets and stars are moving. Galileo argued that this motion was relative, that really the earth was spinning and it only looks like these other objects move. But, both the observations and the Bible indicate quite strongly that the earth does not move. If that is so, then the rest of this "stuff" must be moving. Copernicus, Galileo and Keppler offered persuasion around science to "prove" their views, each declared an axiom that, if accepted, made their views true. Since Copernicus, some have simply declared the "Cosmological Principle," which means the cosmos is homogenous, that the view from all points within it is the same, that the earth is a planet (a wandering star), with no special place in the cosmos. This notion of the cosmos is fundamental to every popular "scientific" theory of the universe since Copernicus, and many of them before him.

For those of us interested in good science, the question remains, "Is this principle valid?" The only possible honest answer is that "Not one shred of evidence supports the notion of cosmological uniformity, and many support the notion that, not only is the "principle" balderdash, but the Earth is actually at the center of the universe. While the details are beyond the scope of **any** essay, the elements can be grasped by anyone:

- If the Cosmos is homogeneous, it must be infinite, for if bounded, the view near the edge cannot be the same as near the center.
- Some argue the cosmological principle could be true if space is "curved" like a hollow ball, thus, no objects on the surface can be said to be at the "center," or they are all equally at the center. This idea is frequently invoked to "explain" problems with the current theories. I believe it is irrational because no one can reconcile it rationally with two questions "With respect to what is it curved?" And "How does a curved surface, explain the three dimensions we clearly observe and measure?"
- Cosmological Red Shift, the observation that light from stars appears to be more red as the distance to the star increases, indicates that stars in all directions from earth are shifted red. If the interpretation of this "redness" is correct, then the earth must be at, or very near, the center of the Cosmos. If incorrect, then "modern science" has no theory of the cosmos, because the "Big Expansion" is dead.
- If the Cosmos is homogeneous and the Earth has no special place in it, then there is a real problem with the extensive

data on quasars gathered by Varshni¹ which shows clearly that virtually half the quasars known at that time were in **concentric spheres around the earth**. Varshni said that the "cosmological interpretation of the red shift in the spectra of quasars leads to yet another paradoxical result: namely, that the Earth is the center of the Universe." Varshni is not a Christian, much less a Geocentrist. He merely pointed out the obvious implications of his research. He proposed an alternative theory of red shift interpretation to solve "the problem." Practically no one supports his alternative, and it appears to be seriously flawed. His research is never directly referred to. It is only called "the quasar distribution problem." Of course it is only a problem to those who insist the earth has no special place in the Cosmos.

Many competent physicists have acknowledged that, unless we can get outside the Cosmos, we cannot prove either a "Sun-centered Solar System," or an "Earth Centered Cosmos," and a number of competent physicists and others have done a good job of demonstrating the truth of this claim. In the following brief list, not one is, or was a fundamentalist Christian, or Geocentrist, yet, in one way or another, all argued and presented considerable evidence, that the physics is the same whether you choose heliocentricity or geocentricity, and that the "proofs" that the earth travels around the sun are not proofs of that view at all:

Of the above papers, six of them demonstrated that a geocentric model of the Cosmos explained as many phenomena as a heliocentric one (one with a sun centered solar system). They also demonstrated that all phenomena used as "proofs" of heliocentricity would behave the same in a Cosmos where the Earth was at the center and did not move. This includes the seasons on the Earth, apparent "retrograde motion" of some planets, the Focault pendulum, oblateness of the earth (bulge at the equator), and the Coriolis effect. None of the authors were geocentric Christians, most did it largely as an intellectual exercise.

Sir Fred Hoyle, one of Britain's leading astronomers summed up 400 years of Cosmological research as

follows: "We know that the difference between a heliocentric theory and a geocentric theory is one of relative motion only, and that such a difference has no physical significance." 2

In spite of all this, anyone who suggests that, "Perhaps the earth does not really go around the sun," is treated as a scientific idiot.

The purpose of this essay is not to assert that geocentrists, or anyone else is right. I do not know who is right, though I strongly suspect that, as He promised, God will "confound the wisdom of the wise." There will be other points later, but at this time I would like to suggest that, unlike Monopoly, or a courtroom, in "science" there is no formal way of picking a winner. What passes for science has always been selected in a manner more equivalent to a political election than anything remotely resembling an objective search for truth. A key change in the last few hundred years is the formation of "scientific societies." The Geologic Society of London, which met in the tavern of the Masonic Lodge, the "Royal Society," the Am. Assoc. for the Advancement of Science, the National Academy of Science, have all ostensibly been intended to foster scientific communication, but they rapidly became, and in some cases were largely formed as, political action groups that behaved little differently than a political party, even much like a religious cult. Just as Republicans do not want Democrats voting in their meetings, so these groups routinely labor to drive from their ranks anyone who does not endorse their favorite theories. From the beginning, politics and religion dominated their intent, thus their favorite theories are, and always have been, selected based on politics and religion (truly neutral "scientific" theories are generally left to fend for themselves). The primary political agenda was getting rid of kings. Since kings had exploited the pseudo-Christian doctrine of "Divine Right," the political goal purportedly fueled the primary religious goal: "anything other than Christianity." Since humanism is always more meanspirited than Christianity (even than pseudo-Christianity) true Christians are nearly all driven from these groups. A recent survey of the National Academy of Science published in a major scientific journal showed, that the cult is very small, and it is 70% atheist!

In the next segment, we'll discuss Quantum Physics, and the modern theories of light and electron. Then we will discuss whether science has disproved "The Law of Cause and Effect, and the 1st and 2nd Laws of Thermodynamics."
